Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Panel - Lt. Brown (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 23" x 43" panel.

From the Urban Legend - Rust (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Brands - Turquoise (C), cut:

- (2) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 1/4" squares. Cut (9) of the squares across both diagonals to make (36) triangles.

From the Urban Legend - Ivory (D), cut:

- (2) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5 1/4" squares. Cut (9) of the squares across both diagonals to make (36) triangles.

From the Star - Black (E), cut:

- (3) 4 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (36) triangles.

From the Cowboy Boots - Black (F), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (2) 4 1/2" x 34 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Star - Turquoise (G), cut:

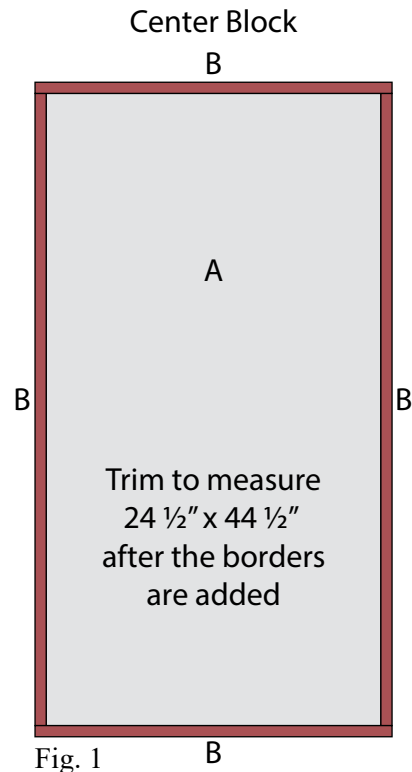
- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Cowhide - Brown (Backing), cut:

- (2) 50" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 50" x 70" back.

Sewing Instructions

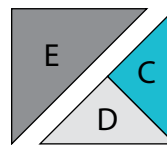
1. Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



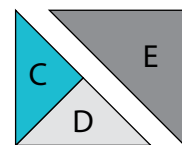
2. Sew (1) Fabric E triangle, (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (18) Block One squares total.

3. Sew (1) Fabric C triangle, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (18) Block Two squares total.

4. Place (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 4). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5) to make (2) half-square triangles (Fig. 6). Trim the blocks to measure $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square.

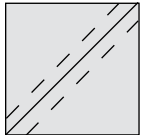

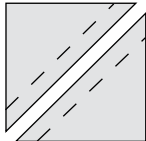

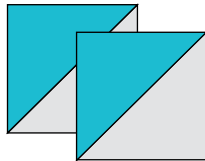

5. Place (1) half-square triangle from Step 4 on top of another half-square triangle, right sides together. Make sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both half-square triangles and the Fabric D Triangle in the top block is opposite from the Fabric D Triangle in the bottom block (Fig. 7).

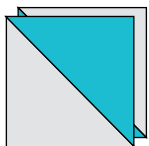

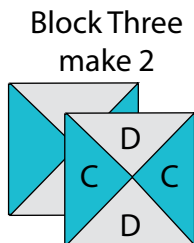

6. Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line (Fig. 8). Cut on the drawn line to make (2) Block Three squares (Fig. 9).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

7. Sew (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares together alternating them. Sew this strip to the top of (1) Block Three square. Sew (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares together alternating them. Sew this strip to the bottom of the Block Three square to make (1) Side strip. Repeat to make a second Side strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

8. Sew (2) Block One squares, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square and (2) Block Two squares together in that order. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

9. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to each end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

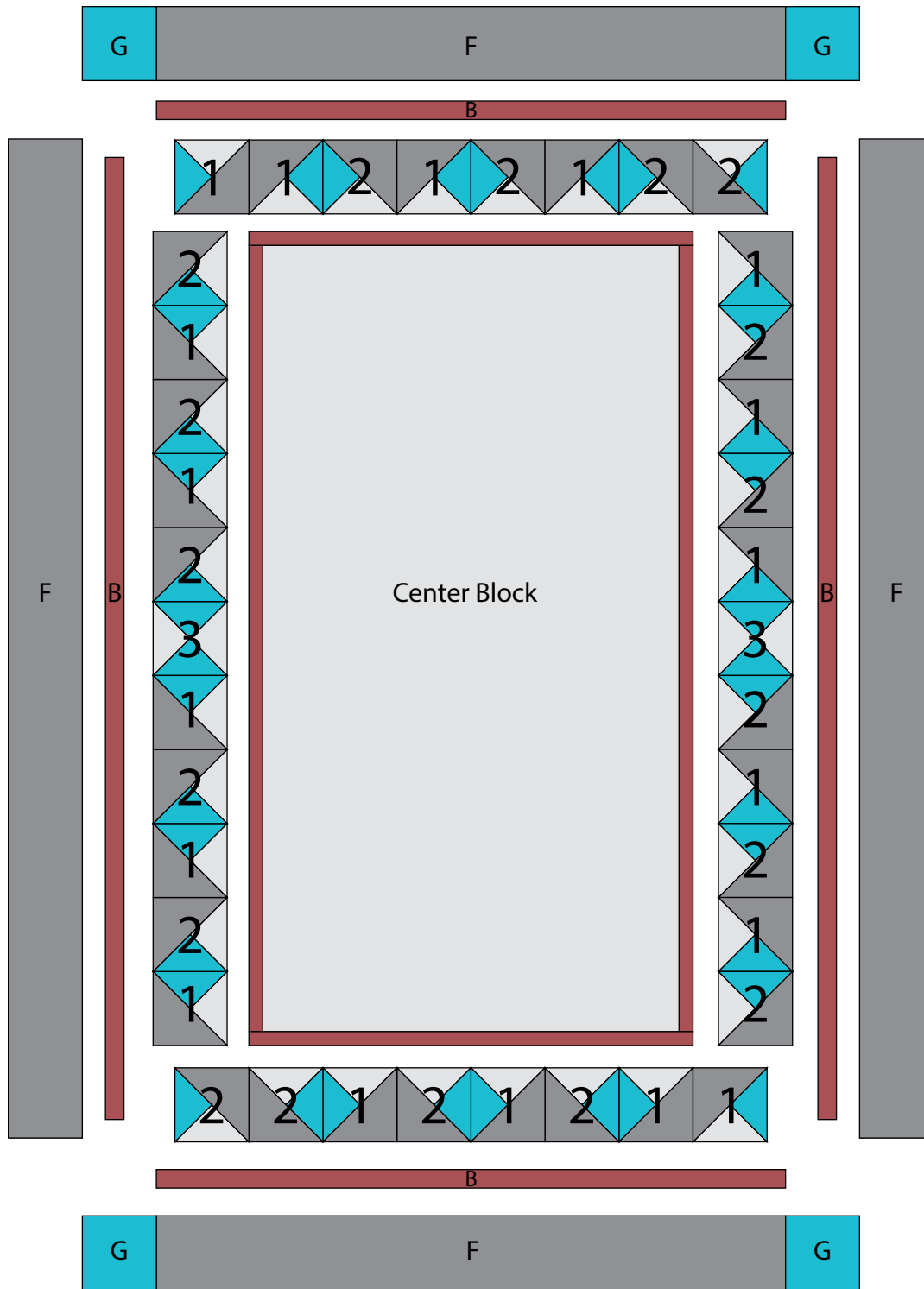
11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
