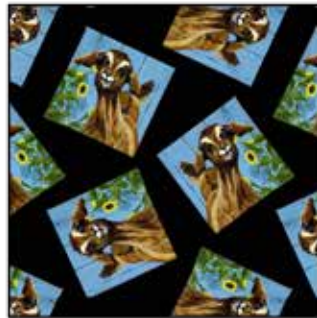

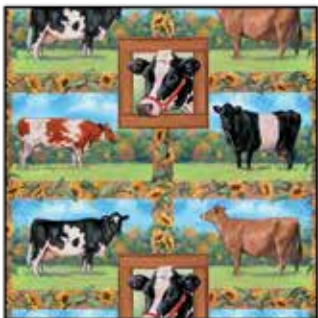

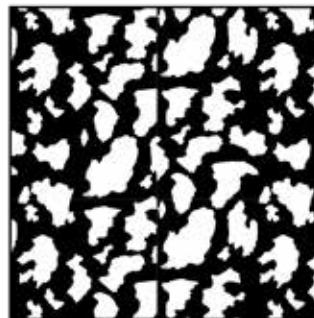

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic Farmstead - Green (A), cut:

- (2) 16 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching the pattern, and cut (1) 16 ½" x 48 ½" strip.

From the Chicken Wire - Tan (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 ½" strips.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (64) 3 ½" squares.

From the Stripe - Black (C), fussy cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 48 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on the red strip.
- (2) 4 ½" x 48 ½" LOF strips, each centered on the field strip.

From the Chicken Allover - Orange (D), cut:

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 6 ½" squares.

From the Cow Spot - Black (E), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Goats -Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 68" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

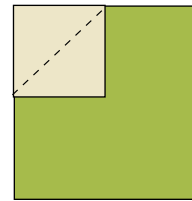

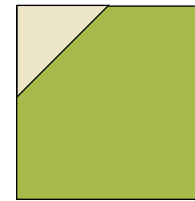

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric D square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (16) Block Ones total.

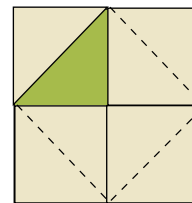

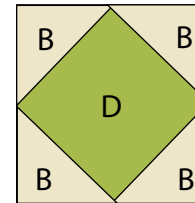

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 5 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric C strip (red strip) lengthwise. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the Fabric C strip lengthwise to make the Row One.

5. Sew (8) Block Ones together. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the pieced strip lengthwise to make (1) Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

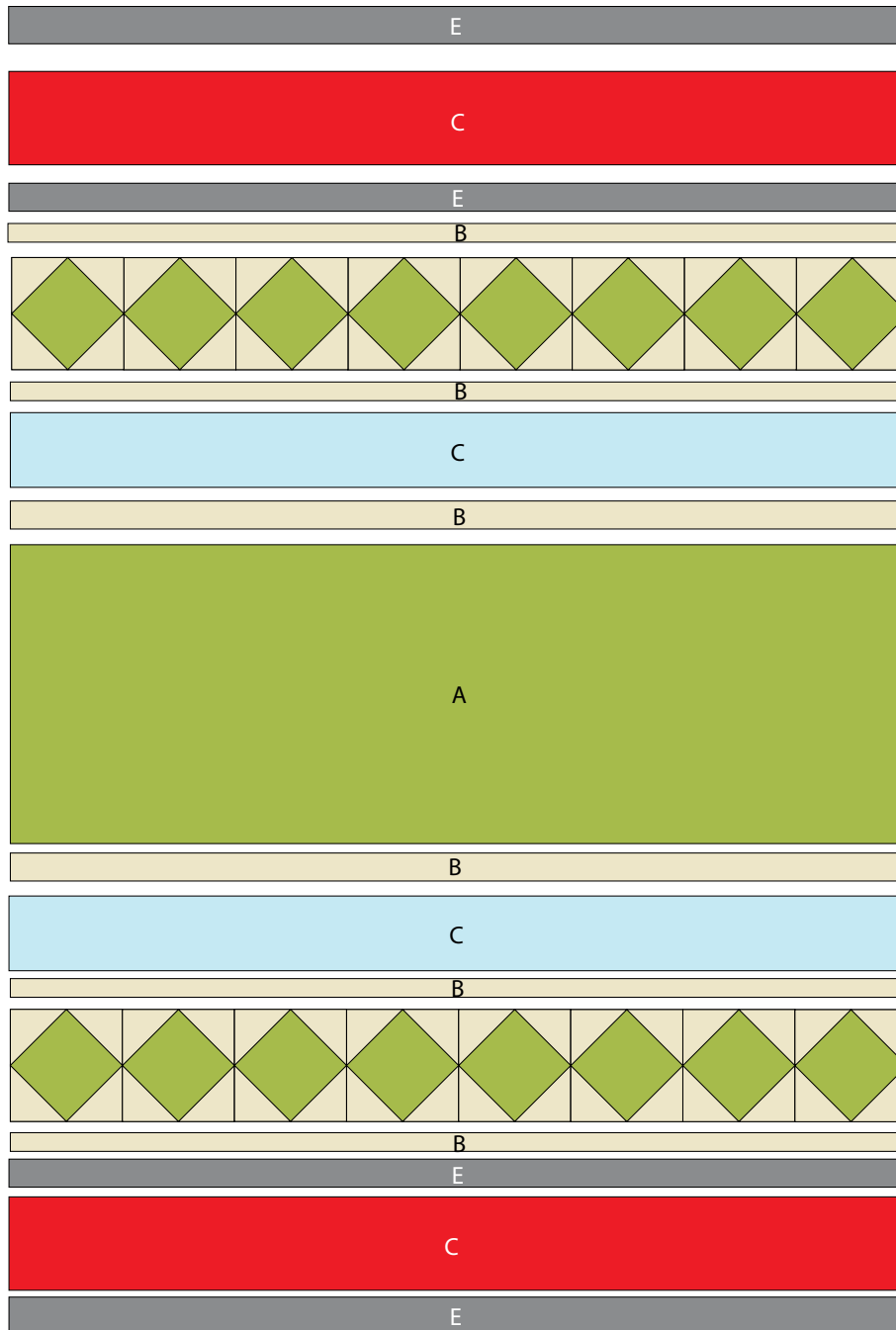
6. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 16 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric A strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric C strip (field strip) to the top and to the bottom of the new strip lengthwise to make (1) Row Three.

7. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 5 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric C strip (red strip) lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric E strip to the bottom of the Fabric C strip lengthwise to make Row Five.

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8. Sew the (5) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
