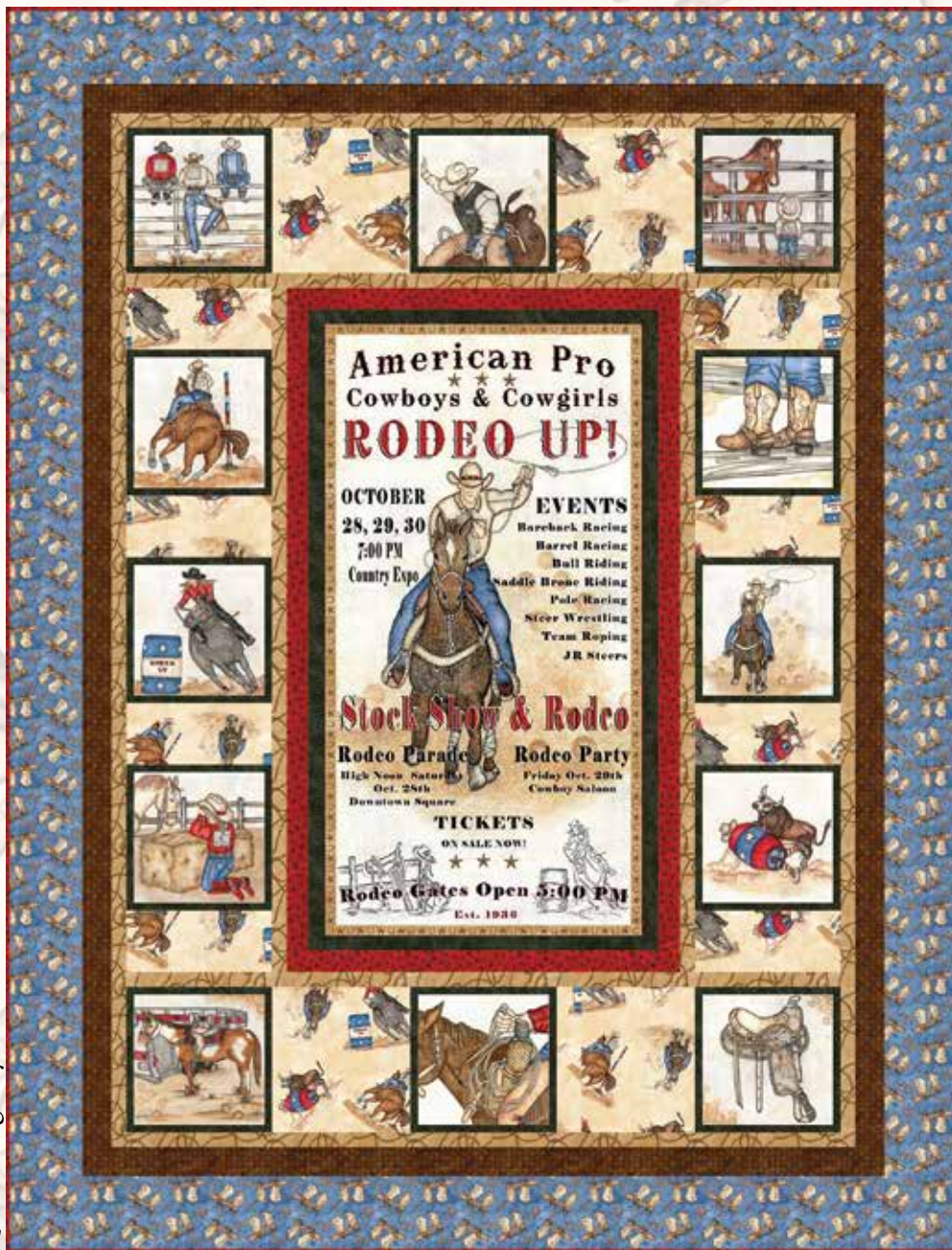

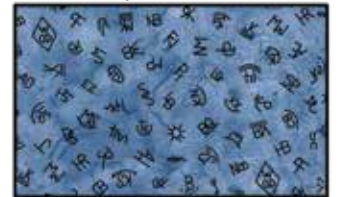

1 yard	Splash - Night (B)	3504-Night
1 yard	Brands - Red (C)	8554-88*
2/3 yard	Rope - Tan (D)	8559-35
2/3 yard	Rodeo Toss - Ivory (E)	8551-41
1 panel	Blocks - Blue (F)	8550-77
2/3 yard	Basketweave - Brown (G)	8555-39
1 1/3 yards	Cowboy Boots & Horseshoes - Blue (H)	8552-75
5 1/4 yards	Rodeo Toile - Tan (Backing)	8557-35

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Rodeo Poster Panel - Ivory (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 22 1/4" x 42 1/2" panel.

From the Splash - Night (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/4" WOF strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the Brands - Red (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 27 1/2" WOF strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Rope - Tan (D), cut:

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/2" x 51 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Rodeo Toss - Ivory (E), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 10" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (2) 4 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 4 3/4" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Blocks - Blue (F), fussy cut:

- (12) 9 1/2" blocks.

From the Basketweave - Brown (G), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips.

From the Cowboy Boots & Horseshoes - Blue (H), cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips.
- (4) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 65 1/2" strips.

From the Rodeo Toile - Tan (Backing), cut:

- (2) 93" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 73" x 93" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 22 1/4" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26 1/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to 24 1/2" x 44 1/2" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 2" x 44 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 27 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 2).

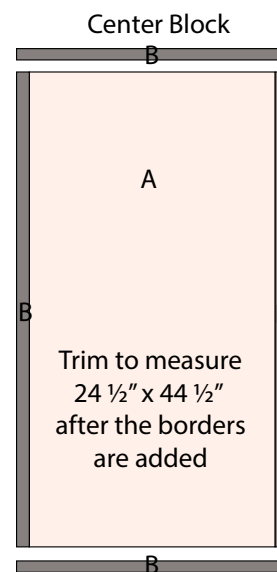

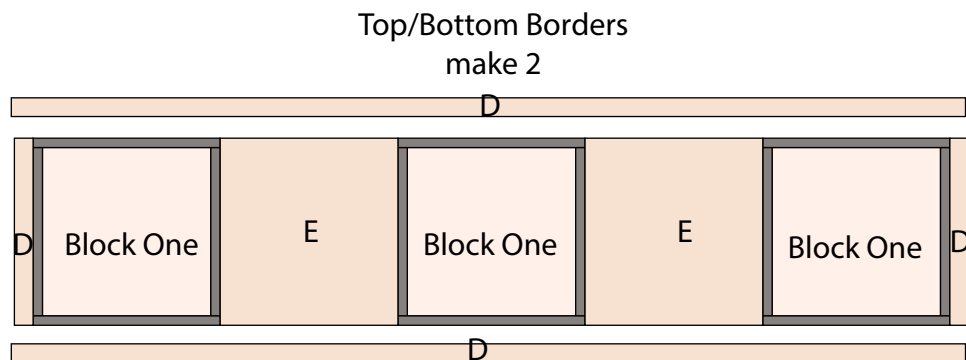
3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F block. Trim the block to measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Block Ones total.



4. Sew (4) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips and (3) Block Ones together, alternating them. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $47\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Block One strip to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



5. Sew (3) Block Ones and (2) 10 " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips together, alternating them. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each end of the strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $51\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom to make (1) Top/Bottom Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

6. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Top/Bottom Border to the top and one to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $71\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $75\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $65\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

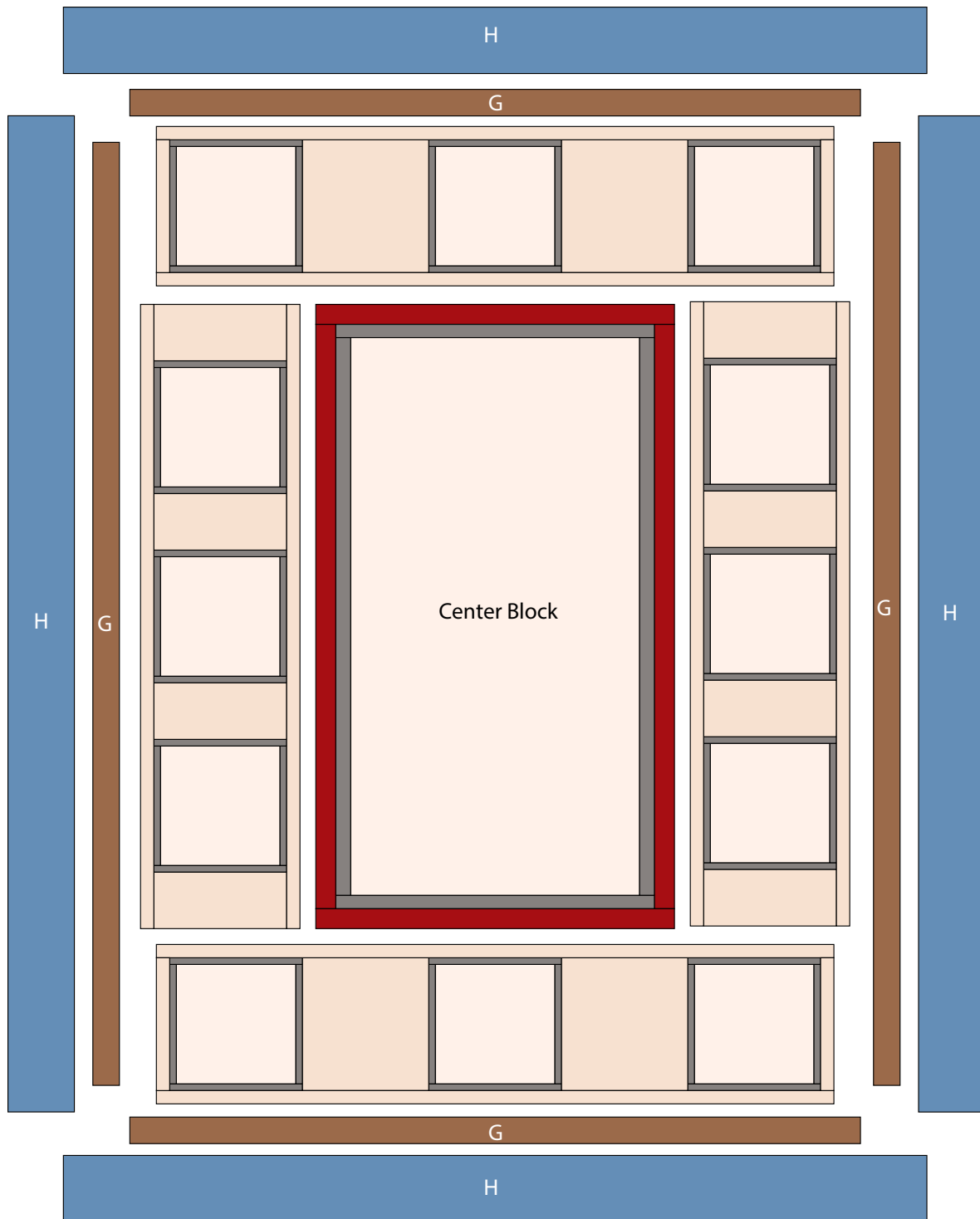
9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
